

## **Emerald City Trapeze Arts Statement Regarding Class Attendance and COVID-19**

In an effort to protect our circus family and the greater community, the Senior Management at ECTA, in accordance with the CDC and WA State Department of Health, provides the following statement pertaining to the COVID-19 virus:

Do your part to prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- **Practicing good personal health habits: stay home when you're sick, cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue and immediately throw it away, wash your hands often with soap and water, and clean frequently touched surfaces and objects.**
- Getting plenty of rest, drinking fluids, eating healthy foods, and managing your stress may help you prevent getting COVID-19 and recover from it if you do.

ECTA wants to keep our students and staff safe and healthy. With this in mind, we are taking extra precautions to clean and sanitize surfaces and equipment. Additionally, we are asking you, our fabulous students, please **don't** come if you are experiencing the following:

- Any new fever and/or new respiratory symptoms (frequent, productive, troublesome cough), shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.

And/Or

- Had any contact with someone from Life Care Center of Kirkland
- Had contact with someone under suspicion or has/had Coronavirus
- Traveled from any infected area within 14 days (China, Japan, Hong Kong, S. Korea, Italy, Iran)

**Before you call ECTA to cancel your class, call your healthcare provider.**

**Be assured you will not be charged a late cancellation fee.**

In an abundance of caution, ECTA will cancel you out of any classes you are scheduled in for the next 14 days per the isolation period advised by the CDC, or until you are cleared to return to class by a medical provider.
